NO Entry Fees:

1. Artist may enter any class, but no more than two entries per class, per person.

Entries:

ONLINE ENTRY IS REQUIRED, and closes on July 25th, 2025. To enter online, go to: clackamascountyfair.com and follow the links to creative exhibits. **Please enter all items that you think you might have completed when you complete your online entries for fair. We can easily delete items that are not completed or ready at time of entry.**

1. If you experience difficulties in completing the online entry process, please reach out to the department superintendent listed above for assistance or colleenrobertcompton@gmail.com for assistance.
2. Entered items accepted Friday, August 1st, 2025 from 1:00 PM to 7:00PM in the Art Department, located in Clackamas Hall.
3. Items accepted Saturday, August 2nd, 2025 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the Art Department, located in Clackamas Hall.
4. It is requested that exhibitors with numerous entries be in the department an hour before closing time.

Exhibitors with more than 20 entries are requested to be on site and in the department a minimum of 1 hour before exhibit intake cutoff so that you can complete the intake process by 7 p.m. Friday or 4 p.m Saturday – NO EXCEPTIONS.

Release Times:

1. Sunday, August 17th, 2025 from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Entries will be checked out at the superintendent’s desk in the Art Department (Clackamas Hall). No entries will be released before 12:00 PM.

2. Premiums will be withheld and the privilege of showings at future fairs jeopardized by anyone attempting to remove entries prior to 12:00 PM Sunday, August 17th, 2025.
3. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE GALLERY. IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO PICK UP YOUR ENTRIES ON THE DATE AND TIME NOTED ABOVE, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO ASSIGN SOMEONE TO PICK UP YOUR ART ON THAT DATE. IF ART IS NOT PICKED UP, IT WILL ONLY BE HELD AT THE FAIRGROUNDS MAIN OFFICE FOR ONE WEEK.**

Specific Rules:

1. **All entries must be original and framed or with wrap-around canvas, WIRED (if you do not have your art work wired and ready to hang, there will be a \$5.00 fee per piece), and ready to hang on peg board hooks. No saw tooth hangers or exceptions. No Makeshift Wires (including tape, string, twisty ties, etc.)** The artist should provide special display props such as pedestals for sculptures.
2. Please attach your name, address, and telephone number to the back of your entry.
3. Judge will critique artwork during the fair, time to be determined.
4. Entries may be for sale. The fair does not collect any commissions.
5. Every reasonable precaution will be taken in handling entries. The Fair cannot assume responsibility for any loss or damage to works.
6. Computer Art: Original artwork of artist may be scanned and manipulated by the computer to make final artwork. Paint box or similar program may be used to create graphic work. A mouse, touch pad, or stylus pencil may be used to create entries. Art works must be framed and ready to hang. Do Not Use computer clip art or pictures taken off the internet or other art banks. Graphic work must be of the artist's original creation.
7. No entries will be allowed that have been shown in the Clackamas County Fair within the last 3 years.
8. All divisions and classes are judged on the American System. Only one (1) 1st, 2nd, 3rd will be awarded per class.
9. In determining special awards for most points earned, the following applies: blue 5 points, red 3 points, white 1 point. In the case of a tie, the winner with the most blue ribbons shall be the winner.
10. No premium will be awarded just because there are no other entries in the class. If the article is not deemed worthy of a 1st place ribbon, it may be awarded a lesser premium.
11. In the case of Overall Division winners, King/Queen, etc., the winner must be a Clackamas County Resident, and an exhibitor cannot win the same award more than 2 consecutive years.
12. Submission of entry implies exhibitor's acceptance of the rules.
13. At the discretion of fair management, any entries that contain nudity or may be deemed lewd or offensive are not allowed.
