ONLINE ENTRY IS REQUIRED and closes online on July 24th, 2026. To enter online, go to: clackamascountyfair.com Follow the links to creative exhibits. If you experience difficulties in completing the online entry process, please reach out to the department superintendent for assistance.

Entered Items Accepted:

Exhibitors with more than 20 entries are requested to be on site and in the department a minimum of 1 hour before exhibit intake cutoff so that you can complete the intake process by 7:00 p.m. Friday or 4 p.m. on Saturday – NO EXCEPTIONS.

1. **Friday, August 7th, 2026** from 1:00 PM to 7:00 PM in the Hobby Hall Department.
2. **Saturday, August 8th, 2026** from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the Hobby Hall Department.
3. **No Entries will be accepted after 4:00 PM Saturday.**

Release Times:

1. **Sunday, August 23rd, 2026** from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Entries will be checked out in the Hobby Hall Department. No entries will be released before 12:00 PM.
2. Premiums will be withheld and the privilege of showings at future fairs jeopardized by anyone attempting to remove entries prior to 12:00 PM Sunday, August 23rd, 2025.
3. NO entries will be returned without your claim ticket present. NO Exceptions!!

Specific Rules:

1. Limit of (1) one entry per class, per exhibitor.
2. Exhibits must be clean and free of cigarette smoke and pet hair. Any item producing strong cigarette smell will not be displayed as it can ruin other entries and our display cabinets.
3. Please make sure you fill out the description of your entry on the entry form.
4. All exhibits to be hung must provide secure hangers.
5. All entries must be new or recently made and must represent the hobby or handiwork of the exhibitor. (No bought items).
6. All entries 2 inches and smaller must be individually fixed on a card.
7. Displays of 2 or more feet must have superintendent’s pre-approval.
8. All reasonable care will be exercised to safeguard entries. Clackamas County Fair will not be responsible for loss of or damage of any entry.

9. All divisions and classes are judged on the American System. Only one (1) 1st, 2nd, 3rd will be awarded per class.
10. In determining special awards for most points earned, the following applies: blue 5 points, red 3 points, white 1 point. In the case of a tie, the winner with the most blue ribbons shall be the winner.
11. No premium will be awarded just because there are no other entries in the class. If the article is not deemed worthy of a 1st place ribbon, it may be awarded a lesser premium.
12. In the case of Overall Division winners, King/Queen, etc., the winner must be a Clackamas County Resident, and an exhibitor cannot win the same award more than 2 consecutive years.
13. Submission of entry implies exhibitor's acceptance of the rules.
14. At the discretion of fair management, any entries that contain nudity or may be deemed lewd or offensive are not allowed.

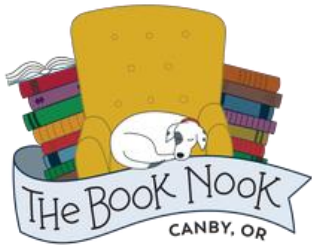
