1. If you experience difficulties in completing the online entry process, please reach out to the department superintendent listed above for assistance.
2. **Due to extremely limited hanging space, we cannot guarantee that your quilt will be displayed unfolded. The Superintendent reserves the right to display quilts folded if needed. Maximum quilt entries are 2 per person with no more than one of these entries being a large quilt. The Fair reserves the right to cap entries at 60 or limit entries to one quilt per person.**
3. **Bring your entered items in on Friday, August 7th, 2026 from 1:00 PM to 7:00 PM in the Main Pavilion.**
4. **Or on Saturday, August 8th, 2026 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM in the Main Pavilion. No Entries will be accepted after 4:00 PM Saturday.**

Release Times:

1. **Sunday, August 23rd, 2026, from 12:00 – 5:00 pm.** Entries will be checked out in the Main Pavilion. **No entries will be released before 12:00 PM.**
2. Premiums will be withheld and the privilege of showings at future fairs jeopardized by anyone attempting to remove entries prior to 12:00 PM Sunday, to be determined.
3. NO entries will be returned without your claim ticket present. NO Exceptions!!

Quilt Divisions Rules and Guidelines

1. **All items entered in this department must be quilts;** items consisting primarily of fabric with a top, batting and backing that are stitched or tied together. Other items, such as fabric collages, wall hangings and table runners, should be submitted in the proper division in Textiles.
2. Quilts must be entered in the correct division based on size, exhibitor’s age, and who quilted the quilt. This chart shows the correct divisions and classes for all quilts.
3. It is preferred that quilts have a 4” wide hanging sleeve attached to the top/back of the quilt for displaying purposes.

Specific Rules:

1. Exhibits which are entered in the “wrong division” will be reclassified at the discretion of the Superintendent.
2. Entries must stay the length of the fair.
3. Please make sure you fill out the description of your entry on the entry form.
4. **All entries must be clean!** No cigarette smell and no pet hair. Judges may refuse to judge dirty quilts.
5. Articles entered for premiums must be completed projects.
6. No article will be eligible for a premium if it has received a prize in previous years at the Clackamas County Fair.
7. Items will be disqualified if they have a price tag or obvious signs of being store bought.
8. All reasonable care will be exercised to safeguard entries. Clackamas County Fair will not be responsible for loss of or damage to any entry.
9. All divisions and classes are judged on the American System. Only one (1) 1st, 2nd, 3rd will be awarded per class.
10. Champion ribbon will be awarded in each division.
11. In determining special awards for most points earned, the following applies: blue 5 points, red 3 points, white 1 point. In the case of a tie, the winner with the most blue ribbons shall be the winner.
12. No premium will be awarded just because there are no other entries in the class. If the article is not deemed worthy of a 1st place ribbon, it may be awarded a lesser premium.
13. In the case of Overall Division winners, King/Queen, etc., the winner must be a Clackamas County Resident, and an exhibitor cannot win the same award more than 2 consecutive years.

14. Special Awards of: Best Patriotic "People's Choice" Quilt, Best Patriotic Quilt Adult, Best Patriotic Quilt Senior, voting will complete at 12:00 noon on Saturday of fair.
15. Submission of entry implies exhibitor's acceptance of the rules.
